1) Times Table Adventure A parent expressed a concern for those children that do not get the support at home with learning their times tables because her own children have required a great deal of support. CW explained that there will always be a variation in the amount of support children get at home. Teachers do spend some time in Maths lessons learning times tables. Some children are also supported in learning their times tables during intervention.	
2) Pupil Visioning CW explained that our annual Pupil Visioning event is taking place this Friday. KS2 and then KS1 gather in the hall to record their views to the following questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Which lessons do you most enjoy? - Which lessons do you least enjoy? - How do you learn best? - What do you want to become when you leave school?
