For any appointments during school time please enter through the Community Hall Doors, If your appointment is after school finishes you will need to enter through **Reception**. Please try to book your appointments via the Website for a better chance of securing the time of your choice—please be aware that this feature is unavailable via the app and will need to be accessed via the desktop version of the website. If you haven't already requested an appointment, or would like to change the time of your appointment, please go to the school's website: www.nanpean.cornwall.sch.uk, and click on the green login button at the top right hand corner. When you have entered your username and password, on the main screen there should be a series of tabs across the top of the screen in a blue bar. Parents Evening is the third option along. Underneath the countdown clock letting you know how long bookings will stay open for, is an option to 'View Event Booking'. If you click on this icon and scroll to the bottom of the page, this is where you can book, or change the time of, your child's appointment. If the site does not give you the parent's evening option at all, please let Miss Dash know, who will investigate this! Please note that there will be no teacher led clubs running during parents evening week.
