| 1) Parent questionnaire <br> Mrs Wicks shared the Ofsted-style questionnaire which parents/carers <br> are asked to complete during parents evening in the spring term. The <br> first 11 questions are the ones that Ofsted ask when a school is <br> inspected and the school has added a few extra ones. This year there <br> are 2 questions about eSchools - the website and the app. The <br> information gathered from the questionnaire is used to celebrate what <br> the school is doing well and how the school can make improvements. <br> A parent was concerned that the newsletter hadn't been sent to <br> parents via the app last Friday so she had told the office staff. This has <br> now been sent via a letter. Mrs Wicks reminded parents that the <br> website is uploaded onto our website for parents to access too. |  |
| 2) School uniform |  |
| Two parents raised some concerns about the proposed uniform <br> changes - as a parent of 3 children she should be able to have 3 <br> votes, ties with a clip might trap fingers, and children with sensory <br> needs might not be comfortable wearing a shirt and tie. <br> Mrs Wicks explained that the children have already made their votes <br> which is why it has now gone to the parents so it is fair for each parent <br> to have one vote. If the parents vote in favour of adding a shirt and tie, <br> different types of ties will be explored. Children with sensory needs do <br> not need to wear the shirt and tie because it an optional extra. |  |
