#### ⇒ Children in Need ~ Friday 16th November

Nanpean School will be taking part in Children in Need on Friday 16th November. The theme of the day is 'Do Your Thing'. Children are free to come into school wearing whatever fancy dress or non-school uniform they want! We are asking for a £1 donation from each pupil for the dress up day, which will go towards our Children in Need fundraising efforts. This year we are also inspired by Team Rickshaw: Each child and staff member will Freestyle a mile to collectively complete the distance equivalent to the Cornish Coastline—A massive 296 miles! Children can skip, hop, walk, or use any other manner of moving for their mile. We will also allow children to scoot their mile if they wish. If they choose to complete their mile on a scooter, however, they must bring in their own scooter and an acceptable safety helmet. For safety and storage reasons, we will only allow scooters to be brought in from home; not a variety of equipment. This endeavour will be a sponsored challenge and so children will be taking home a sponsorship form in due course to raise some additional money for Children in Need if they wish to. All money raised by Nanpean School will be donated to the Children in Need fundraising effort.

→ Year 6 Visit to Brannel School ~ Tuesday 13th November

Our year 6 children will be visiting Brannel School on Tuesday

13th November for a day long transition visit. This visit will be
based in Brannel's 'Create' wing and a number of D.T based
activities have been planned. Brannel have made arrangements

The immunisation will be the application of a nasal spray to all pupils whose parents have completed and returned the consent form. ## ⇒ Sugar Smart ~ Health & Wellbeing

We will be sending home to all parents a 'Sugar Smart' leaflet, which has been issued by Cornwall Council. This is a nationwide campaign supported by Jamie Oliver and Sustain. It aims to promote a healthy diet and reducing our sugar consumption, by providing the children with healthy snacks such as fruit or vegetables, no fizzy drinks or sports drinks. Please help us by being 'Sugar Smart' at school.

#### ⇒ Medical Appointments

Where possible please could you make your child's medical appointment out of school time as we do not want children to miss out on their school work. If unavoidable, please could you bring a copy of the letter / appointment card to the office so that a copy can be taken for our records.
