Were The Dark Ages Dark?

In this Unit, 'Were The Dark Ages Dark?' pupils learn about the links between Scandinavia and the British Isles. In History, they learn about the Invaders and Settlers who came to Britain from Scandinavia and North Western Europe during the period 450 to 1066 A.D. Through our work in Art, English and History pupils learn about the cultural treasures of the Scandinavian world: from stories, myths and legends to musical instruments, games and jewellery. Norse Mythology, in particular, provides a rich source of stimulating stories around which there are many opportunities for creativity and imaginative work.
