

Maths

Following the White Rose Maths units for Year 1 we will investigate place value through sorting and counting.

Science

Exploring the materials people use to make structures to shelter, house and transport animals (pets, farm, zoo and wild animals) and how the materials are chosen for their qualities of, for example, strength, lightness, transparency, flexibility, water tightness, etc..

Include a visit to the village to see how materials have been used to make hous es, homes for livestock, transportation of animals, how materials are used in local building work where houses are being built with straw bale, wood frame or brick and block construction methods.

Art and Design Technology

Investigate simple shell and frame structures in terms of strength and joins. Make a structure in a team to:

- Investigate different ways of joining different frames and create a frame for a picture of the three pigs or Wolfie.
- Investigate hinges and design a shell of frame house to keep a little pig safe from the Wolfie.
- · Make and test the secret hinge mechanism.

Local Links

We will take a walk around Nanpean village to discuss the different buildings we can see.

Final Product: We will work together on a 'big build' on the school field, trying to build a shelter we can all fit inside.
