#### ⇒ <u>Attendance</u>

A quick reminder that we have amended our Attendance Policy regarding term time holidays as of Friday 23rd November 2018. The new procedure is as follows: If a child reaches 10 sessions of unauthorised absence (the equivalent of 5 school days), then we will refer the matter to our Student Welfare Officer: Caroline Hunt, who will issue a first warning letter. If that child accrues any further sessions of unauthorised absence within a 10 week period, then we will refer the matter to Cornwall Legal Services who may decide to prosecute. A conviction may result in a fine of up to £2,500, a prison sentence of up to three months or both. Alternatively, a penalty notice may be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in court action.

Nanpean School will not authorise any leave of absence except for in exceptional circumstances. Please note that authorisation of absence is at the discretion of the head teacher and an absence may not be authorised for any number of reasons: If we are not provided with evidence of a medical appointment, if we are unable to establish why a child is absent, or if a child arrives after 9.30am, are examples of absences which will not be authorised. Additionally, if you report that your child is absent due to illness, but we have reasonable reason to doubt the accuracy of this statement or if your child suffers from frequent illness that has led to them becoming a persistent absentee, we will be within our rights to request evidence from your child's doctor confirming the illness. If your child is having any problems that you feel are affecting their attendance, please speak with your child's class teacher or Miss Morton so that we can offer support.

#### ⇒ Term Time Holidays ~ Myth / Truth

**Myth:** "It's not really 'law', it's just something the school says to keep their figures up"

**Truth:** Section 7 of the Education Act 1996 places a duty upon the parents/carers of compulsory school age children to ensure that their child receives an efficient, full-time education.

What Cornwall Council Say: Children must attend the school they are registered in. Only the school can authorise a child's absence. If a child is not registered or does not attend their educational provision, Cornwall Council may take legal action against the parent /carer, if appropriate.

#### ⇒ Absence Due to Illness ~ Myth / Truth

Myth: "They need to be absent for 48 hours after sickness" Truth: If your child has sickness and diarrhoea then YES, they should be absent from school for 48 hours. If your child has had sickness due to other reasons and feels well the next day, please encourage them to attend school.
