English:

Writing

Story writing—Creating comics and stories about superheroes.
Instruction writing—How to catch a villain!

Grammar

Simple sentences with a capital letter and full stop. Time word sentences. Question sentences. AA sentences (Noun phrases). Sorting word types (noun, verb, adjective). Past and present tense.

Spelling

Revision of Year 1 spellings.

Handwriting

Letter formation practise.
Size of capital letters, ascenders and descenders.
Beginning to join.

Guided Reading

We will be reading stories about superheroes including: Supertato by Sue Hendra and Superworm by Julia Donaldson

Maths:

Read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words.

Recognise the value of each digit in two digit numbers.

Compare and order numbers from 0-100.

Count in steps of 2,3 and 5, from 0, and in tens from any given number, forwards and backwards.

Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 and use facts up to 100.

Add and subtract one and two digit numbers.

Art and design:

We will learn about the importance of eating '5' a day. We will try lots of different fruits before choosing our own combination to make a smoothie. We will evaluate our smoothies and also invite our parents to give us feedback too.

Art: We will learn to mix new colours with primary colours and how to create shades of the same colours. We will use our new mixing skills to create a skyline for our superhero silhouettes.

Music: We will be creating our own sound effects with percussion to go with our superhero storytelling. We will also be singing songs which change tempo and rhythm.

Science: We will be thinking about what humans and animals need for survival. We will also discuss the importance of diet and exercise.
