Objectives

To raise attainment and achievement of pupils to at least expected levels through

- ❖ Supporting pupils' speech and language skills, through individual intervention
- ❖ Supporting pupils' self-confidence, through individual intervention (e.g. Draw & Talk and CLEAR counselling)
- ❖ Supporting pupils' motor skills through group intervention (e.g. Fun Fit)
- ❖ Supporting pupils' reading skills, through individual and group intervention and incentives (e.g. Better Reading Partners, Code X, Comprehension support, Accelerated Reader)
- ❖ Supporting pupils' writing skills, through individual and group intervention (e.g. phonics, letter formation, sentence structure, RWInc, Freshstart)
- ❖ Supporting pupils' maths skills, through individual and group intervention (e.g. same day intervention, calculation strategies, Maths Mastery)
- ❖ Ensuring pupils' access to school clubs, holiday clubs and trips/residentials
- ❖ Ensuring pupils' high school attendance

Outcomes

- ✓ In EYFS, 33% of Pupil Premium pupils achieved a GLD, compared to 0% in 2016-17.
- ✓ In Year 1, 78% of all pupils passed the phonics screening check (81% national, 2016); an increase of 15% from 2017.
- ✓ In Year 1, 4 out of 5 of PP pupils passed the phonics screening check, with pupil number 5 having joined our school in June 2018 and is also Child In Care.
- ✓ In Year 2, 80% of PP pupils met the expected in reading compared to 61% of all pupils.
- ✓ In Year 2, 60% of PP pupils met the expected standard in writing compared to 46% of all pupils.
- ✓ In Year 2, PP pupils performed better than non-PP pupils in reading and writing.
- ✓ In Year 6, 33% of PP pupils had special educational needs.
- ✓ The 3 PP children who were classified as Persistent Absentees in 2016/17 were not classified as persistent absentees in the 2017/18 academic year.
