⇒ Christmas Fair ~ Wednesday 19th December

Our Christmas Fair will be taking place on **Wednesday 19th December from 1.30pm.** Class teachers will release all children from their usual end of day exits to permitted adults at 1.15pm to walk around and enter the Fair through the hall main doors. Drinnick and Karslake Class will be performing a selection of classic Christmas songs in Drinnick's outside area from 1.15pm and so children in these classes can be collected from Drinnick's external door following their performance. Please note that children who are on our unaccompanied list, will not be released until 3.10pm unless they are collected by an adult. The Hall doors will open for the Fair at 1.30pm. Children not collected at 1.15pm will be supervised by school staff in Karslake class room, so if you are running late, please walk around to the Year 3 class room to collect your child. These children will still have the opportunity to visit the Fair in small groups under the supervision of school staff. Once you have collected your child from the classroom at 1.15pm, staff will no longer be responsible for your child, and so you are free to leave once you have browsed the Fair. Again, we ask if anyone can help with the prepping or setting up of the Fair, please inform the office.

⇒ **We will be going Paperless-ish!**
To be more environmentally friendly, and to allow more money to go into educating children and delivering our curriculum, we will be going paperless for all communications that do not require parental response from January 2019. This means that all newsletters etc. will be uploaded to the website and sent out via eSchools. We are giving advance notice to give parents/ carers opportunity to log in to their eSchools account. Please do ensure that you check the newsletter each week as key information is sent out in this. Parents/ carers not checking the newsletter is not an acceptable reason for missing crucial information about school events. If you have no internet access at home, and will still need paper copies, please let the office know.

⇒ **ePay on eSchools**
This week was our first week using ePay through eSchools. If you have sent cash into the office, we will pay this towards your account on Fridays. Please take the time to have a look at the ePay system if you have not yet paid for your child's meals this week. You can log in by visiting our school website: www.nanpean.cornwall.sch.uk and clicking on the green 'log in' button in the top right hand corner of the screen. Once you have logged in, ePay should be visible as an option on the main selection bar. If not, you can access it by clicking on the '>>' icon at the end of the menu bar and follow the instructions from there. Please remember that the system doesn't currently allow for the 5 meals for £10 discount. This discount will be added manually on a Friday for the week and this is when we will be sending out payment reminders via eSchools. We will also be invoicing parents/ carers for outstanding dinner money owed prior to this week through ePay. This will be set up as a separate payment request and will detail the dates of dinners ordered and what balance is outstanding. If you do not know your eSchools log in information, please speak with the office.

⇒ **Attendance Facts!**
National Expectation of Good Attendance
The National Expectation of Good Attendance is 96%. Nanpean School expects all children to at least meet this expectation and monitor those who fall below this expectation carefully throughout the year to ensure that as many pupils as possible meet this attendance percentage.
Unauthorised Absence Penalty Fines
We would like to make parents/ carers aware that fines for unauthorised absences will be £60 per child per parent. The regulations define a 'parent' as an adult who resides in the child's home and is present for the unauthorised absence (e.g. goes on the unauthorised holiday). Please note that unauthorised absences are not limited to unauthorised holidays; arriving late to school (after 9.30am) without a sufficient reason, and not speaking with staff to explain an absence sufficiently are all reasons why absences will be unauthorised.

⇒ **Final Celebration Assembly of 2018**
Today was our final celebration assembly of 2018. We used this time to celebrate our Stars of the Week, Lunchtime Award winner, and any outside achievements our pupils have gained throughout the week. We also celebrated the pupils who have had 100% attendance for the term and we are pleased to see that approximately 50% of our pupils have attended school every day this term! Well done to all these pupils! For those who didn't quite make it this term, you have the opportunity to achieve 100% attendance in the Spring and Summer Term.
