To be more environmentally friendly, and to allow more money to go into educating children and delivering our curriculum, we will be going paperless for all communications that do not require parental response from January 2019. At Nanpean School we strive to build a strong relationship with parents/ carers. ⇒ <u>ePay on eSchools</u>

We will be trialling ePay on eSchools for the next couple of weeks. Unfortunately, it is not as flexible as we would like so this will be a time where amendments to the system may be required to meet our school's needs. ePay will be automatically linked to the dinner ordering system. However, the system doesn't currently allow for the 5 meals for £10 discount. This discount will be added manually on a Friday for the week. Parents/ carers can access ePay via the eSchools app or webpage. You may still pay using cash if required.







⇒ Cancelled After School Clubs ~ w/c 10/12/18

We appreciate that clubs not running can be frustrating for parents/ carers however, we would like to remind you that clubs are run voluntarily by staff and are not to be used as guaranteed childcare. Please remember that administrative staff are the messengers, so when we are required to remind you that clubs are cancelled, please do not take your frustrations out on them! We do endeavour to give parents/ carers as much notice of club cancellations as possible, but it is important that the newsletter is checked every week for cancellations so that alternative arrangements can be made in good time. Monday 10th December; Stay and Play Club cancelled to allow for KS1 nativity preparations.
