CONSEQUENCES

• House points (glass stones):

- great effort with learning
- great achievements
- great behaviour
- tidying up collaboratively
- helping others
- improved score for times tables/ spellings

• TA (teaching assistant) awards:

- super achievements
- super effort
- super behaviour in class/group work
- super behaviour at breaktimes/ lunchtimes

Busy Bees (Headteacher certificate & wristband):

- independent learning
- exceptional behaviour
- exceeding expectations with learning
- exceptional citizenship

• Star of the week:

- exceptional behaviour and learning all week

• Lunchtime award:

- exceptional behaviour at breaktimes/ lunchtimes

• Unacceptable behaviour:

- continually calling out
- deliberately distracting others
- saying unkind things to someone
- refusing an adult's request
- answering back

• Consequences:

- 1) Reminder of expectation
- 2) Warning and clear choice given
- 3) Sanction given (choose from the following):
 - Sent to partner class to complete work
 - Complete work at break/lunchtime
 - Complete 'Time to Think' sheet at break/ lunchtime
 - Teacher talks to parent

• Severe behaviour:

- physically hurting another person
- using abusive language
- throwing equipment/damaging equipment
- putting myself or others in danger
- bullying another child (including cyber-bullying)

• Consequences:

- Sent to Headteacher to complete 'Time to Think' sheet at lunchtime/ after school
- Headteacher contacts parent
- Fixed term exclusion
