'Night Day at the Museum'

Day at the Museum:

The classroom will become a museum of the Ancient Greeks for the day in the last week of half term. Children will spend the half term creating all the museum exhibits and artwork.

Topic Launch: Pupils will take part in an archaeological dig on the school field

English

Myths– After sharing some Greek myths such as the Minotaur, Children will write their own 'myths' about a terrible creature they design.

Script Writing– Children will write a script for a short scene about Greek Life that will feature as a museum exhibit.

Art and Design

Children will take part in a pot making workshop and design and make a Greek inspired pot.

Computing/e-safety

Children will be using a variety of ICT equipment and apps for the museum. E-safety will be discussed around the theme of 'consent'.

Maths

This term we will be working on formal methods of division and comparing and ordering fractions.

History

Children will learn about the timeline and events of Ancient Greece and the influence the early society still has on modern life.

Geography

We will learn about Greece and compare and contrast with our own country.
