

# The Pupil's Commitment

## I will do my best to:

- \* Work hard to achieve the best that I am capable of.
- \* Attend school regularly.
- \* Arrive at school on time with the correct equipment.
- \* Wear correct school uniform.
- \* Remember to take home my book bag and complete my homework on time.
- \* Take care of the school environment and keep it free from litter.
- \* Be helpful and show respect to all members of the school community.
- \* Make sure my parents/carers receive letters and return any forms promptly.
- \* Behave well in school and in the wider community (see Behaviour Agreement).

## During Covid-19, I will do my best to:

- \* Follow the social distancing rules, where possible, in class and in the playground.
- \* Tell an adult if I feel unwell.
- \* Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school that are not allowed.
- \* Only use the equipment provided to me by school.
- \* Not mix with any other year group in the school.
- \* Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate.
- \* When coughing and sneezing use "Catch it", "Bin it" and "Kill it".
- \* Wash hands regularly– use soap and water for 20 seconds and hand sanitiser regularly.
- \* Behave well at all times to keep myself and others safe.
- \* Follow the safety rules and know that if I am purposefully not following them, there will be consequences as per our behaviour policy.

## The School's Commitment

### We will do our best to:

- \* Develop each pupil's abilities and talents and support them to reach their full potential.
- \* Teach carefully prepared lessons and set appropriate work that will be marked regularly and returned promptly.
- \* Recognise and celebrate each pupil's success through the use of verbal feedback and certificates.
- \* Encourage high standards of behaviour in the school and the wider community.
- \* Set and mark homework in line with the school's policy.
- \* Provide parents with information about their child's progress at least three times each school year.
- \* Keep parents informed about school activities through letters and the website.
- \* Contact parents if a pupil is absent from school who is on the unaccompanied list.
- \* Contact parents if we have concerns about a pupil's learning or behaviour.
- \* Create a safe, secure and happy environment for learning.
- \* Listen to our pupils and treat them with respect.
- \* Play a full and active part in protecting our pupils from harm and work with other agencies to identify, assess and support those children who are suffering harm.

### During Covid-19, we will do our best to:

- \* Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.
- \* Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can, both in and out of school.
- \* Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic need.
- \* Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19.
- \* Inform you if staff or children in your child's year group bubble have tested positive for Covid-19, as this will mean that all children in this bubble will need to self-isolate for 14 days from the time of their last contact with the person who tested positive.
- \* Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement.
- \* Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website.

## The Parent/ Carer's Commitment

### I will do my best to:

- \* Encourage my child to work hard and achieve the best that he/ she is capable of.
- \* Make sure my child goes to school on time and is properly equipped.
- \* Ensure my child has good attendance, avoiding unnecessary absence (e.g. medical appointments and holidays in term time).
- \* Inform the school by 9.00am if my child is absent and provide an explanation of the absence (at that time or on his/ her return to school).
- \* Make sure that my child wears correct uniform in accordance to school policy.
- \* Ensure that my child does not bring to school unnecessary items from home.
- \* Inform school staff of any problems that might affect my child's learning or behaviour.
- \* Check my child's book bag regularly and encourage him/ her to complete homework to a high standard.
- \* Attend meetings to monitor my child's learning.
- \* Support the school to maintain good behaviour and discipline on school premises and, where appropriate, on school transport.
- \* Encourage my child to take advantage of opportunities that the school offers outside the classroom.

### During Covid-19, I know and understand that:

- \* If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- \* If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.
- \* When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- \* I will be on time when dropping off and picking up.
- \* I will ensure that only one parent and carer will drop off and pick up.
- \* My child will not bring any unnecessary items into school with them not agreed by the school.
- \* My child may have their temperature taken during the day if they feel or present as being unwell.
- \* I will remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow.
- \* I will teach my child how to wash their hands properly, following Covid-19 guidelines.
- \* I will remind my child about the importance of "Catch it", "Bin it" and "Kill it" for coughing and sneezing.
- \* I need to support staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment.
- \* I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- \* I will provide up to date emergency contacts details.
- \* If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.
- \* I understand that if my child is unwell at school, he/ she will be immediately isolated from other children and staff.
