A quick reminder of our payment procedures for all money being handed into the school: any money less than £20 must be handed into either the black post box in reception or the children's class boxes in an envelope with the child's name, the amount in the envelope and the purpose of the money. This is the case for the majority of income into the school, including tuck, swimming, trip payments and school dinner money. There are envelopes available in reception to make this easier for parents. Class boxes and the office box is checked on a Monday (or the first day of the school week, if there is a holiday/ inset day) and Wednesday. Any income over £20 must be handed into the office and a receipt will be given for this amount.
