<b>1) Covid-19</b> MN discussed Covid-19. Parents were extremely positive about the school's response to this and thanked MN and staff. All stated that the children and families have been kept safe, while all have also been constantly informed, so parents praised the leadership / management and organisation in relation to this. There was one suggestion about Remote Learning Map to be added to Class Dojo pages, so that children absent can easily access this. Two parents also said they would rather children reverted to bubbles, and that clubs etc... were cancelled, if it was required to prevent any spread of Covid-19 is cases increase. <b>2) Curriculum Updates</b> MN explained that we continue to focus on Ofsted Action Points as priorities, and explained in further detail about our Curriculum (acronym FAB on our Curriculum Statement, Knowledge-engaged, and that we have clear coverage and defined expectations ('End Points') now. MN then explained the next steps are refining the Progression of Skills (PoS) to Key Essential Skills (KES) and creating Knowledge Organisers for each subject in each year group.	Subject Leaders.
<b>3) AOB</b> Two parents suggested new sports kits (and perhaps PE Kit) for the school. MN stated that we have planned to purchase some in the Summer Term (for September 2022). Finally, MN asked parents if they knew why only 3 people had attended. MN explained that some parents who usually attend had given apologies due to other commitments, such as work. Parents then stated that some parents don't probably feel the need to attend as MN always keeps parents informed via Newsletters, Class Dojo etc... (all parents stated that our communication from school to parents is excellent). They also said that MN is always available to talk to parents, if required, and they see their child's class teacher at drop off to classes every morning, so can always talk to them as well. MN thanked parents for this positive feedback.
