## ⇒ Children in Need ~ Update

On Friday 16th November Nanpean School took part in raising money for Children in Need. So far, we have raised £131 for Children in Need. If your child has been asking for sponsorship for the 'Freestyle your Mile' activity that took place, please ensure this money is returned with the sponsorship form by Friday 30th November. Thank you to everyone for taking part and donating money.

#### ⇒ **Attendance**

At Nanpean School, we place huge importance on the value of good school attendance to improving both a child's academic and social development. Not only this, but it is a parent/ carer's legal obligation to ensure that a child of school age receives an efficient and full time education. If parents or carers take their child(ren) out of school without permission, they will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. Unfortunately, we have had an unprecedented number of unauthorised holidays take place this term which has prompted Miss Morton and Mr Nicholls, with advice from our Student Welfare Officer, to review our attendance policy and procedures, especially regarding the taking of holidays in term time. We would like to make all parents/ carers aware of our new procedure regarding unauthorised absences as from today:

If a child reaches 10 sessions of unauthorised absence (the equivalent of 5 school days), then we will refer the matter to our Student Welfare Officer: Caroline Hunt, who will issue a first warning letter. If that child accrues any further sessions of unauthorised absence within a 10 week period, then we will refer the matter to Cornwall Legal Services who may decide to prosecute. A conviction may result in a fine of up to £2,500, a prison sentence of up to three months or both. Alternatively, a penalty notice may be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in court action.

Nanpean School will not authorise any leave of absence except for in exceptional circumstances. Please note that authorisation of absence is at the discretion of the head teacher and an absence may not be authorised for any number of reasons: If we are not provided with evidence of a medical appointment, if we are unable to establish why a child is absent, or if a child arrives after 9.30am, are examples of absences which will not be authorised. Additionally, if you report that your child is absent due to illness, but we have reasonable reason to doubt the accuracy of this statement, we will be within our rights to request evidence from your child's doctor confirming the illness. If your child is having any problems that you feel are affecting their attendance, please speak with your child's class teacher or Miss Morton so that we can offer support.
