⇒ <u>eSchools and ePay</u>

It was reported in the most recent Parents' Forum that some parents/ carers are having trouble accessing their eSchools account. As we are increasingly using this means to communicate with Parents/ Carers it is especially important that you are able to access the app or the desktop site. If you are consistently having trouble with this, please speak with Miss Dash as soon as possible as we may need to raise an issue with eSchools who provide this system. The majority of letters are uploaded to our school website, so please check there in the mean time if you are not able to get into eSchools. All outstanding debts for school dinners have also been added to ePay. Please use this system to see whether there is an outstanding balance. You can also use this system to pay for school dinners rather than bringing cash into school.







Spring Term Clubs
