This year our Summer Fair will be taking place on Wednesday 27th June from 1:30pm to 3pm and everybody is welcome to join us in celebrating the end (almost) of the school year! Children are invited to come to school in their favourite non-school uniform clothes on Wednesday 27th June. For this opportunity, we are asking for either a £1 voluntary donation towards the cost of putting the Fair on, or a donation of cakes for our cake stall. Donations and cakes can be dropped into the office from Monday 25th June. On Wednesday 27th June, please collect your children from their usual exit doors and head around to the hall entrance doors. Staff will be very busy setting up the Fair, so please do not venture out on to the field until 1:30pm. If the weather is poor, the Fair will be moved into the school hall and KS2 classrooms. Children who are not collected for the Fair will be supervised by staff in Karslake classroom. As staff will be running stalls, any child not collected promptly at 1:15pm will be sent up to be collected from Karslake class. All children will have the opportunity to look around the Fair so you can send money in with your child in a named envelope on the day of the Fair. A Seasonal Warning

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We would like to make parents/ carers aware that we have had a number of reports that parents/ carers have found ticks on their children. It is tick season and we do limit this pest by keeping the main playing field grass short and preventing access to long grass unless children are wearing wellies. Please ensure you check your children for ticks as leaving them in can cause serious illness. If you discover a tick and are not comfortable ensuring you can get the whole thing out, please see a doctor within 24 hours.
