## ⇒ School Meals in September 2017

As you may be aware, Nanpean School will be taking over the contracts for the kitchen. This means that there will be a few changes in September. One being a **BRAND NEW MENU!** A copy is attached



to this newsletter and it will be available to view on our website in the near future and will have exciting new options. School meals will cost £2.30 per day but we will not be continuing Chartwell's 5 meals for 4 scheme. We will continue to review the cost of school meals over the year to ensure that they provide great value for money. We will be looking into online payments over the next year but for now, cash must be sent in on a Monday for the week in a named envelope, specifying that the money is for school meals. Cheques will now need to be made payable to Nanpean School.

# ⇒ New Year 3 pupils — School Meals Sept 2017

Just a reminder that if your child is going into Year 3 (Karslake) in September, they will need to pay for school meals as the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme does not apply to children in Year 3 and up. Children who are in receipt of Pupil Premium (and consequently Free School Meals) will continue to benefit from this next year no matter what year they are in. More information concerning this has been sent home in a separate letter to parents of pupils currently in the new Year 4. ## ⇒ Payment System Reminder

A quick reminder regarding sending money into school. We do not accept loose money either at the Office or in classrooms. Payments less than £20 must be in a named envelope and either posted in the locked box in the Office or children can hand it in in the classroom to be sent to the Office, this includes payment for book bags. Class and Offices boxes will be checked on a Monday and Wednesday only. All income will be checked and change sent home where applicable on those days. As with this year, tuck and school dinners must be paid for on the Monday for the rest of the week, or you can pay termly. Please ensure that if your child wants tuck or school dinners on a particular day, that you write this on the envelope but bear in mind that if your child wants tuck on a Tuesday and you give them the money on a Tuesday, this will not be received by the Office until Wednesday. Any money put in the money post box loose or not named, will be kept in the Office until the end of the half term and then banked as a school donation. Any payment over £20 must be brought to the Office directly so that a receipt can be issued. Money for fundraising (for example, Children in Need or dress up days) will be collected by class collection pots. We will be investigating online payment options further in the new academic year.
