⇒ New Reception

⇒ Change of Contracts

⇒ Payment for School Meals—from September

As mentioned above, Nanpean School will be providing school meals in house from September. This means that any payments for school dinners will be managed by Nanpean School. From September, any cheques should be made payable to NANPEAN SCHOOL. At the end of each week, if there has been no payment from pupils or staff, a slip will be sent home requesting payment. If payment has still not been received and the outstanding balance reaches £20.00, a letter will be sent home with your child requesting payment and stating that they must bring packed lunches until the outstanding balance has been paid.

Apprentice, who will work closely with Mr Tonkin to develop sport and P.E provision at our school.
