⇒ Nanpean School Open Days



Attendance

We would like to remind everyone that at our school we place huge importance on the value of good school attendance in improving both a child's academic and social development. Not only this, but it is a parent/carer's legal obligation to ensure that a child of school age receives an efficient and full time education. We would like to remind all parents/carers of the following:
-If you take your child out of school without permission you will be committing an offence under section 444 of the Education Act 1996.

- -A referral with our School Welfare Officer will be issued where a child has had 10 sessions of unauthorised absence.
- -The Local Authority has the authority to issue penalty notices on behalf of the school if a child has 10 sessions of unauthorised absence.
- -As a result, if a child of school age has at least 5 days unauthorised absence during a 10 week period, we will be initiating the procedure that could result in penalty notices being issued to parents.

Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in court action.

No leave of absence will be authorised except for in exceptional circumstances and this is at the discretion of the Head teacher. Additionally, if you report that your child is absent due to illness, but we have reasonable reason to doubt the accuracy of this statement, we will be within our rights to request evidence from your child's doctor confirming the illness. If your child is having any problems that you feel are affecting their attendance, please speak with your child's class teacher or Mr Nicholls.
