#### $\Rightarrow$ Times table Adventure

We are continuing with our Times Table Adventure which was launched last year. Children are supposed to learn all their times tables up to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4. Mr  $2 \times 4 \times 5 \times 12$ Barritt, our Maths Lead, wrote an adventure



story to motivate the children to learn their tables. In Fridays Achievement Assembly, we will be announcing who has passed any levels on the Times Table Challenge that week.

#### $\Rightarrow$ Parents Forum ~ 04/10/2017

Wednesday 4th October was the first Parents Forum of the year. Two parents attended to discuss the following topics with Mrs Wicks:

1) News board—A parent wondered if it was possible to put a big whiteboard out the front with reminders on, e.g. parents forum. Mrs Wicks felt carrying a free-standing board out would be cumbersome, however the school could purchase a whiteboard to be attached to the railing. 2) Speeding—The parents expressed their concerns over why there isn't a 20mph speed limit in Nanpean. Mrs Wicks



explained that this is something the school does not have much influence over. The PCSO has been on site many times with his speed gun and there hasn't been any issues with speeding during drop off and collection times.

In fact, the volume of traffic during these times, helps to slow the traffic down. There have been some near misses so the question will be posed to the Health, Safety and Wellbeing team.

3) Photos—A parent was disappointed that in the sibling photo one child was not smiling. Mrs Wicks apologised but explained that the majority of the family and individual photos were very successful.

4) eSchools website/APP—A parent asked if communication could be improved by putting more information on the website and texting parents about class events. Mrs Wicks agreed to check that class letters are on the website.

5) Key Stage 1 Tuck—Mrs Wicks explained that it is taking a long time for the younger children to choose their tuck resulting in them not having any time to play-parents will be consulted about the possibility of stopping tuck for Key Stage 1 as they get free fruit anyway. In the meantime, Eden class will go to break 5 minutes early to get a head start with choosing their tuck.
