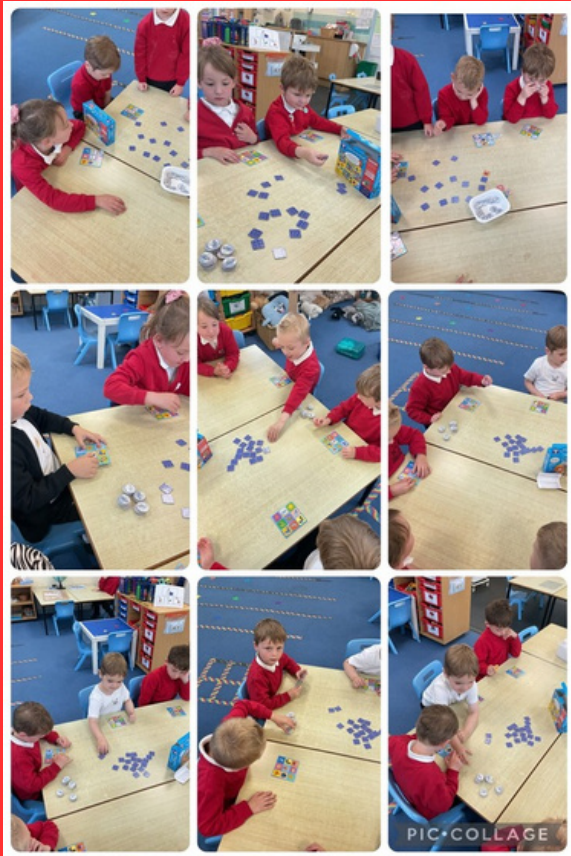

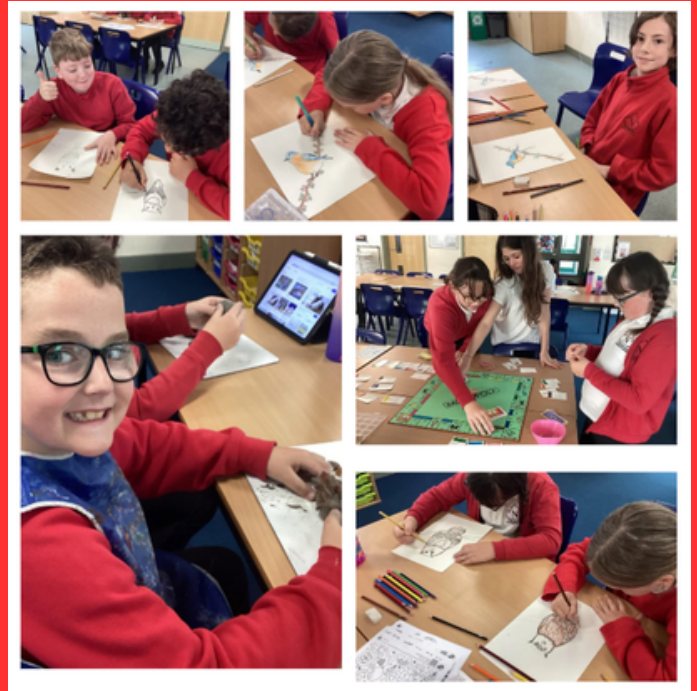


## MELBUR CLASS

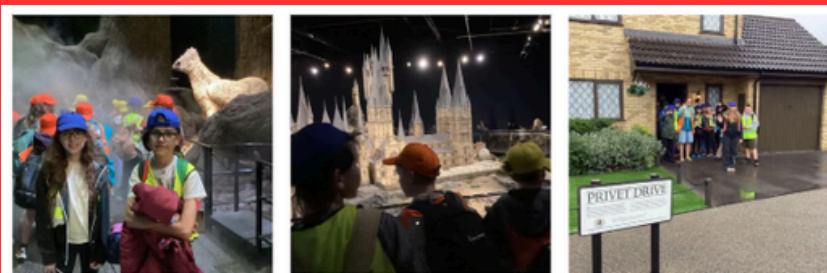
## DRINNICK/ROSEMELLYN LONDON RESIDENTIAL
